1. Teacher's Opening Comments:

1. You will see a video about Foundational Values. In this video, Chandak ji talks about three important Values. 1. Good Citizenship. 2. Moral character 3. Social Service Respect others. Maintain good health. Maintain Cleanliness & Hygiene at home, school & public places. Be kind. Have discipline. Help elders, neediest & weak.
2. The Teacher appoints 2 students for making the CLOSING comments at the end of the program.
3. Closing comments: explain in 2-3 minutes. i. how the meeting went, and ii. what do you think about the Video?

Teacher Plays the video. After the Video is done. The Teacher forms Groups and appoints group leaders.

After the discussion, teacher invites the group leaders to talk. After that invites the two to make closing comments. After that the teacher will ask if anybody has a question. And then gives his/ her closing comments.
