1. Teacher's Opening Comments:

You will see a video about Innovation. In this video, Chandak ji talks about three important Innovation skills. 1. Be a change maker. 2. Be inquisitive. Inquire. Ask questions. Go to the roots. Think of new ideas. 3. Be resilient. Stick to your plan. Do not quit till the goal is met.

2. The Teacher appoints 2 students for making the CLOSING comments at the end of the program.

In closing comments explain in 2-3 minutes. i. how the meeting went, and ii. what do you think about the Video?

3. Teacher Plays the video. After the Video is done. The Teacher forms Groups and appoints group leaders.

Teacher: The innovation video talks about: i. Nothing remains the same. Everything is changing. Be aware of the changes and competition and their impact on our lives. ii. think how to make things better, cheaper and faster. Be curious, observant, and inquisitive. ask questions. iii. Be determined. Do not quit till you find the solution.

4. Teacher distributes the Questions. Repeat the questions or teacher may add his own questions, if required.

5. Group Leaders will make sure that everyone understands the questions and participates in the discussion. After the discussion, the group leaders to explain in 2-3 minutes, their group's answers and what they think about the video. You have 12 minutes.

Teacher: Please start the discussion.

6. After the discussion, teacher invites the group leaders to talk. After that invites the two to make closing comments. After that the teacher will ask if anybody has a question. And then gives his/ her closing comments. End.
