1. Teacher's Opening Comments:

You will see a video about Leadership. In this video, Chandak ji talks about three important leadership skills. 1. Try to know what and who you are. Always respect yourself. Don't think less of yourself. 2. Take a lead, take initiative. 3. Be a good communicator.

2. The Teacher appoints 2 students for making the CLOSING comments at the end of the program.

In making closing comments you will explain in 2-3 minutes. i. how the meeting went, ii. what do you think about the Video?

3. Teacher Plays the video. After the Video is done. The Teacher forms Groups and appoints group leaders.

Teacher: The Leadership video talks about: i. you should know your strength, weakness, what you can and cannot do, your likes and dislikes. ii. SWOT analysis. iii. You should be proud of yourself and not compare yourself with others. iv. You should come forward, take initiative, take charge, lead the team. v. knows how to talk with people, listen to others, how to express your thoughts and ideas.

4. Distributes the Questions. If there are more than 4 groups; then repeat the questions or the teacher may add his own questions.

5. Now the Group Leaders will make sure that everyone understands the questions and participates in the discussion. After the discussion, the group leader will explain in 2-3 minutes, what is their group's answers to the questions and what do they think about the video. You have 12 minutes. You may talk in Marathi, English and Hindi.

Teacher: *Please start the discussion.*

- 6. After the discussion, teacher invites the group leaders to talk. After that invites the two to make closing comments. After that the teacher will ask if anybody has a question. And then gives his/her closing comments. **End.****

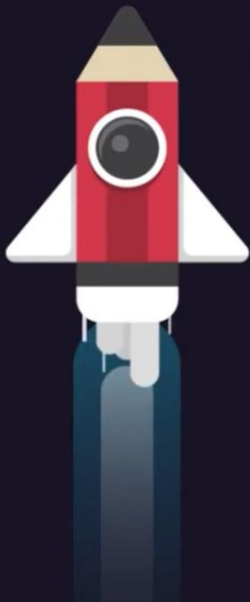
S – Strength
